BRIGHT IDEAS GRANT

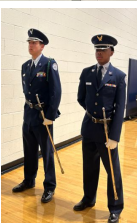
Congratulations to Ms. Sarah Thompson who was a 2023 Bright Ideas Grant Winner!

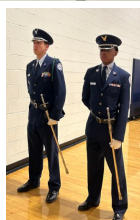
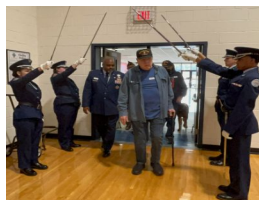


★★★★★ DÍA DE LOS VETERANOS

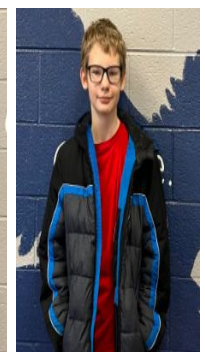
